We can take them!**

**From February 14<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup>** you'll find a pickup station for used garments **at ESU residence in 5 Corte Maddalene**. Just like in the yellow urban dumpsters that you see all across the city, you'll be able to leave there your items of clothing, shoes and bags, as long as they are in good condition.

# WHAT CAN YOU PUT INTO THE BOX?



## Make him happy!

Select only items of clothing, shoes and bags in good condition. Put them into transparent bags and close them. Shoes should be tied together as a pair: we can't always go on a treasure hunt (and that's a pity)! Say goodbye to your old clothes and think about their new life!



## Don't make him cry!

DO NOT put any items of clothing in very bad condition, since they would have to go directly to a garbage dump and they wouldn't be able to help anybody. Odd shoes or shoes in very bad condition. Blankets, curtains, home textiles, pillows, balls of wool as well as fabric scraps, carpets, games, books, pans, dishes, electrical appliances... the right place for all these items is the eco-center!

**Vestiti Contenti** is the pickup program for used garments all across Verona and surroundings. The clothes are collected in the yellow bins, which are overseen by *Cooperativa Sociale Centro di Lavoro San Giovanni Calabria*.

### Is it better a garment in the hand or a job in the bush?

The garments that you donate do not go directly to people in need. Instead, they are re-introduced into a supply chain: the proceeds of their sale allow us to finance long-term socio-professional inclusion projects. To offer someone a work opportunity means to guarantee them a dignified way of life: a huge value for the whole community.

### Their end is our beginning.

We are *Cooperativa Sociale Centro di Lavoro San Giovanni Calabria* and we've been managing the employment of people with social disadvantage since 1975. Every week we collect 40 tons of used clothes across Verona and surroundings: an activity that relieves the municipalities of their disposal while creating work opportunities for dozens of people.
